- ◆ Ensure your child(ren) have a **water** bottle everyday.
- ◆ Ensure your child's uniform is **name labelled**, including their coats.
- ◆ Children bring their **reading book and diary** to school everyday.
- ◆ Any **lost property** will be stored in the entrance to the school hall. It can be collected at the end of the school day with a parent/carer.
- ◆ **P.E kits** are to be worn on the day of your child's P.E lesson. No football kits or gymnastics outfits are allowed.
- ◆ Break time snacks must be **fruit or vegetables only**.
- ◆ If your child is entering school by themselves please be aware that the school **gates are locked until 8:30am**.

Looking After Your Child's Teeth

Healthy teeth help children eat, speak, and smile with confidence. Forming good habits early makes a big difference!

Simple Top Tips

- **Brush twice a day** – morning and bedtime.
- **Use a pea-sized amount of fluoride toothpaste** (just a smear if under 3).
- **Supervise brushing** until your child is at least 7.
- **Choose water or milk** instead of sugary drinks.
- **Keep sweets and treats to mealtimes** to protect teeth.

Visiting the Dentist

Regular check-ups are really important.

- **NHS dental care is free for children.**
- Children aged **3-16 can have fluoride varnish** painted on their teeth at least twice a year.
- This simple treatment helps **strengthen teeth and prevent decay.**
