









Pinehurst Primary School Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter Autumn 1 2023

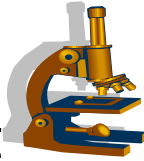
The information on this sheet will give you a brief overview of some of the activities we will be doing this term across the curriculum. Please feel free to contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions or can offer any help.

English	Maths	Computing
<p>In English we will be reading <i>The Unforgotten Coat</i> by Frank Cottrell Boyce. There will be lots of different writing opportunities including: persuasive writing and formal and informal letter writing.</p>  <p>There will also be daily guided reading session, during which we will look at a different extract each week (fiction, non-fiction or poetry) and develop our reading skills.</p> <p>Children are encouraged to read every night at home and bring their completed reading record into school.</p>	<p>In Maths we will be studying in depth place value and the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.</p> <p>We have a 'Maths Basic Skills' session every day which will include skills linked to our lessons, as well as times table and arithmetic practice.</p> <p>Children are also encouraged to use Times Table Rock Stars at home regularly to improve fluency and earn extra Dojo points.</p> 	<p>In computing we will be reviewing our knowledge of computer science and revisiting important concepts like algorithms, debugging and logical reasoning.</p> <p>We will revisit Scratch and then move on to looking at simple, text-based programming languages such as Javascript and Logo.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>We will be learning invasion games and gymnastics. We are lucky enough to have an LFC Foundation coach working with us for this term. We will also have weekly swimming lessons.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>In RE this half term our topic is '<i>What do religions say when life gets hard?</i>' We will be exploring the 'big' questions in life such as where do we come from and where do we go after we die in the context of different religious beliefs.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE our topic is 'Me in my World' and we will be looking at our dreams and goals for the future. We will be looking at any worries that may come with this and how we can overcome them. We will also be discussing our feelings and roles and responsibilities within the school environment.</p>

In this half-term we are hoping to have the opportunity to visit the Liverpool Anglican Cathedral to support with our Art, RE and Geography topics. As a scientist we will be learning about Electricity:

- We will be learning different symbols and drawing simple circuits.
- We will make predictions based on what we know about electricity and carry out fair test using electrical equipment, including, wires, bulbs, buzzers and motors.
- We will record and present data using scales.
