#### English

#### In English we are reading the story 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl.

During this half term we will be exploring Roald Dahl's amazing descriptions of to 1000. Children will also learn the value of each digit. Children will also the various rooms inside the factory. We will also be creating and building character profiles. We will explore Roald Dahl's use of language, including his use of 'made up' words and his repetition of specific words throughout the story. We will complete our learning by writing our own chapter about a new invention room. At times we will watch clips from both films, comparing text alongside both the modern and original film.

#### Maths

#### Our focus this term will be on Place Value and building our Times Table skills.

Our focus will be on Place Value. This involves reading and writing numbers up count in jumps of 50 and 100. Following on from this we will explore our 4 and 8 times tables. We will continue too practice basic arithmetic skills including counting, mental addition and times tables, as well as our daily basic skills sessions.

The children will be able to access TTRockstars from home using their own personal logins.

### Computing

In computing our topic is 'Be Internet Legends' (E-Safety). This covers information which should be kept private online, looking at the risks of phishing, how to protect personal data and look at attributes of a good digital citizen.
