The information on this sheet will give you a brief overview of some of the activities we will be doing this term across the curriculum. Please feel free to contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions or can offer any help.

English

In English we will be reading The Promise by Nicola Davies. There will be lots of different writing opportunities including poetry and writing our own narrative with a dilemma.



We also have a daily shared reading session, during which we will look at a different extract each week (fiction, non-fiction or poetry) and develop our reading skills.

PF

This half term we will focus on health related fitness. Children will learn about circuit style activities and discuss how different movements work different parts of the body.



Maths

This half term we will be starting Further Multiplication and Division as well as starting our Fraction topic which will include reading, comparing and adding and subtracting fractions

We have a 'Maths Basic Skills' session every day which will include skills linked

to our lessons, as well as times tables and arithmetic practice.



Computing

In computing we will be developing our digital literacy by making our own music.



We will begin to explore a range of online music

making software. Children will try out a variety of different sounds, rhythms and effects before creating their own piece of music.

There will also be plenty of opportunity to use technology to enhance other subjects across the curriculum.

PSHE

In PSHE our topic is Dreams and Goals.

We will be discussing our hopes and dreams and looking at steps of how to achieve our goal.

We will also explore strategies for overcoming disappointments.

In RE this half term our topic is 'Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?'

In our RE lessons we will be finding out about the impact that believing in Jesus can have on a Christian's life and how Jesus has inspired some examples of contemporary inspirational Christians

There will be many opportunities for discussion and collaboration.


Visits and Visitors Building our Cultural Capital

- We will be challenged to make our own switch and connect it to a circuit.








As a Geographer...

Types of Natural Resources






As a linguist we will be learning to:
