We will be continuing with daily phonics sessions.



Our topic is- Finlandia

We will explore the work *Finlandia by Jean Sibelius* and learn about instruments of the orchestra. We will listen to a new piece of music, explore loud and quiet sounds make sounds on our body. We will also sing in different languages, hear music from another country, move to a pulse and to music and play classroom instruments.

This half-term our topics are...



As a Scientist

As a scientist we will be learning about: *Plants and Seasonal Changes (Focusing on Winter-Spring)*

We will be identifying and describing the basic structure of a common flowering plant, including trees. We will discover how the trunks of trees are similar and different from each other. We will draw and label a plant, e.g. roots, stem, leaf, flower, petal. We will observe and plant seeds and bulbs.



Seasonal Changes in the UK

As a geographer we will be looking at seasonal changes in the UK. We will learn the UK countries and capitals We will explore the four seasons and how they impact daily life. We will also make seasonal weather predictions.



As an Artist

We will be finding out about the artist **Wassily Kandinsky** and his work. Focusing on colour, line and shape. We will find out about primary and secondary colours and create our own piece of work in the style of Kandinsky.



As a Linguist

We will continue to revise previous topics, such as numbers, colours and emotions. We will also look at vocabulary for the world around us.
