



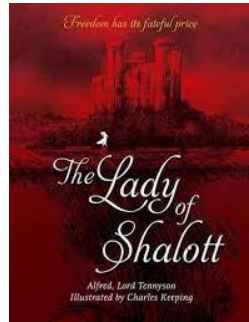
Pinehurst Primary School

Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2 2024

English

In our English lessons we will be studying the narrative poem *The Lady of Shalott* by Alfred, Lord Tennyson. We will explore the themes and structure of the poem before writing our own verse with an alternate ending.

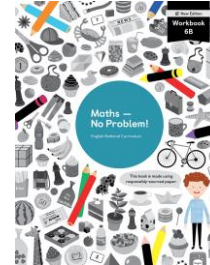


We will also discuss gender stereotypes and roles and write biographies about inspirational people who have challenged these expectations.

Maths

In Maths we will be studying:

Negative Numbers
Area and Perimeter
Volume
Graphs and Charts



We will continue with our reasoning based approach and have daily maths basic skills sessions in which we will focus on our arithmetic skills and fluency.

Music



Our music lessons this half term will focus on Indonesian Gamelan music. We will explore the background and style of the music then play on percussion instruments as part of a class ensemble.

PE

We are lucky enough to have a coach from the LFC foundation working with us this half term. We will also build on leadership skills, sportsmanship and working as a team player. PE is every Tuesday and Pinehurst PE kits need to be worn to school on this day.



RE

In our religious lessons we will continue to consider the question: Is it better to express your religion in in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity?

We will discuss how different religions express their beliefs through religious art work, buildings and statues and how different faiths give back to their communities.



PSHE

Our PSHE topic is Healthy Me.



The children will learn and discuss how to be healthy both emotionally and physically. They will explore different scenarios with each other and offer advice on how to live a healthy lifestyle.
