English

Tackling themes of anxiety and agoraphobia with sensitivity and sure-footedness, The Boy in the Tower mixes urban realism with science fiction as strange plants cause tower blocks to tumble all around Ade and his mother. Ade loves living at the top of a tower block. From his window, he feels like he can see the whole world stretching out beneath him. His mum doesn't really like looking outside - but it's going outside that she hates. The book is written by Polly Ho-Yen

Maths

This term we will focusing on a few different topics, including Geometry, Position and Movement and Measurement. Accompanying our core topics this term, we will be supplementing our learning with basic skills. This will be a mix of previously taught topics and principles.


Shared Reading

In shared reading this half term, we will be looking at a variety of different texts. These include *Gorilla*, by Anthony Brown, and A handbook for dreamers and thinkers, where we will be focusing on Naoko Yamazaki's journey and inspirations as an astronaut.

In each of the texts we read, we will explore various reading skills such as inference, retrieval, and sequencing.







PΕ

In PE this term, we will be focusing on HR Fitness. This will include participating in wall and net games. Children will continue to apply and develop a broader range of skills, learning how to use them in different



ways. This will be delivered by one of our LFC coaches, and will run til half term.

RE

Children will consider the question: If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship? Within this topic, children will understand what a place of worship, and what different places of worship look like.

They will go on to compare different places of worship. The children will debate different questions surrounding places of worship and present ideas of how Christians embody Jesus and worship God in different ways.

PSHE

Our PSHE topic this half term is *Relationships*. We will be considering how we make friends and how we can solve problems which arise with friends. Children will go on to consider how they can respect themselves and others, and to know how to help themselves and others when feeling hurt or upset.

Minimalism


With our fantastic music teacher Hannah, will be studying minimalism
