Communication and Language

Learn songs and Nursery Rhymes
Circle time to talk about self and interests.
Learning new vocabulary related to the harvest
and Autumn

Communicating when playing, learning to interact with new children and adults.



Physical Development

Developing gross motor (big movements) and fine motor (small movements) control

Develop correct pencil grip.

Traveling/ negotiating space, moving safely in different ways when playing and in P.E sessions.

Learning to be independent with belongings, clothing, toileting and food.



Personal Social and Emotional Development

Focus on settling the children back into school for Nursery returners and welcoming in new children.

In our Circle time we will be thinking about:
How it feels to belong and that we are
different and similar; recognising and
managing feelings; working with others to
make school a good place, understanding why
it's good to be kind and use gentle hands.



Literacy - Reading and Writing

Book talk, Early Reading skills, direction of print etc.

Stories linked to themes and interests.

Giving meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint.

Begin to recognise own name.



Maths

Learn to count up to 5 and to count objects using one to one correspondence.

Learn rhymes counting up to 5.

Learn the days of the week and the months of the year.

Learning about themselves and their families, Talking about past experiences, special times or events for family and friends.
