This will include work on our 3, 4 and 8 times tables. We will There will be lots of different writing opportunities including an adventure also practice solving word problems related to multiplication and division. Computing

Being Internet Legends

Children will describe what a good 'digital citizen' looks like. They will able to identify whether information online is reliable and be able to identify what types of personal information should never be shared online. Children will also be supported to recognise potential scams online.



Why is the Bible important for Christians today?

This unit is part of the **Believing** strand of our agreed Liverpool RE sullabus. The children will look at the sacred texts linked to different religions. Stories and parables from these texts will eb shared with the children.

Celebrating Differences

In this Puzzle (unit) the class learn about families, that they are all different and that sometimes they fall out with each other. The children talk about techniques to calm themselves down and discuss a technique called 'solve it together.' The children revisit the topic of bullying and talk about being a witness (bystander), they took about how a witness has choices and how these choices can affect the bullying that is taking place. The children also talk about using problem-solving techniques in bullying situations. They talk about namecalling and choosing not to use hurtful words. They also talk about giving and

receiving compliments and the feelings associated with this.

We will investigate packing, why it is used and learn how to use nets to construct 3D shapes. We will also explore different fonts to use on packaging.
