Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter Spring I 2026




The information on this sheet will give you a brief overview of some of the activities we will be doing this half-term across the curriculum. Please feel free to contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions, or can offer any support.

English

Our main English text this half term will be "[The Tin Forest](#)".

We will continue to be doing shared reading sessions each afternoon to develop the children's reading, comprehension and inference skills. We will send home another Spellings Booklet of Year 1 and 2 Common Exception Words for children to practice throughout the week at home. We will be sending home Spelling Shed accounts again for each of the children so they are able to practice their spellings and reading skills interactively at home.

Within English lessons, we will continue to develop their handwriting; focusing on the correct formation of letters and building fine motor control.



P.E.


In P.E we will be doing athletics and some elements of dance. The children will be supported to develop fundamental movement skills, becoming increasingly competent and confident, and access a broad range of activities to extend their agility, balance and coordination.

PE will take place every **Monday** this half-term.



Maths

This half term in [Maths No Problem!](#) we will learn about Mass in Chapter 6, Temperature in Chapter 7 and Pictograms in Chapter 8. To aid with the children's understanding, we will be sending home mathematical challenges based around these chapters. We will also send home Numbots logins for the children. This will support them in their understanding of their times tables.



Computing

Children will learn the importance of how to use technology purposefully to store and retrieve digital content, and to recognise common uses of information technology beyond school. They will create digital content and explore photo editing software. We will also celebrate Safer Internet Day on Tuesday 10th February 2026.



R.E.

In R.E, we will be learning about different places of worship with the question: **What Makes Some Places Sacred?** World Religion Day is celebrated on Sunday 18th January 2026 and Chinese New Year starts on Tuesday 17th February 2026.



P.S.H.E.

Our Jigsaw PSHE topic this half term is Dreams and Goals. This jigsaw piece focuses on choosing realistic goals and thinking about how to achieve them.
