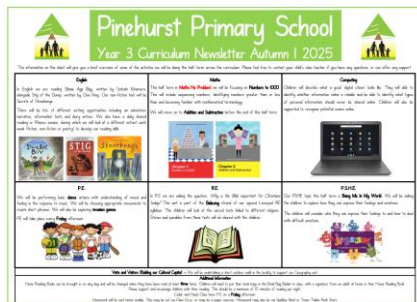
Alternatively, you may call the school office on 0151 263 1300 and we can arrange a mutually convenient time to speak on the phone.
