

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

On Time: First Time, Every Time



Which CIRCLE are you in?

Good attendance is essential for every child's learning and wellbeing. The DfE expects pupils to attend **97% or above**, which means **no more than 5 days of absence** across the school year. Even small amounts of time missed can lead to gaps in understanding and reduced progress.

Impact of Poor Attendance

Missing just one day every two weeks adds up to nearly a month of lost learning. Lower attendance can affect confidence, routine, and long-term achievement. Punctuality is equally important—arriving 10 minutes late each day adds up to over **30 hours of lost learning** a year.

Absence Procedures

If your child is unwell, please **call the school office before 8:45am** and provide a clear reason. The school may ask for evidence for medical absences longer than one day. Routine appointments should be made **outside the school day** where possible. If unavoidable, children should attend school **before and after** the appointment to receive their registration marks.

By working together, we can ensure every child at Pinehurst has the best chance to succeed. If you need advice or support with attendance, please contact Mrs Steers, our Designated Attendance Lead.


