Thank you, too, to our Governing Body for their ongoing guidance and support throughout this busy term.

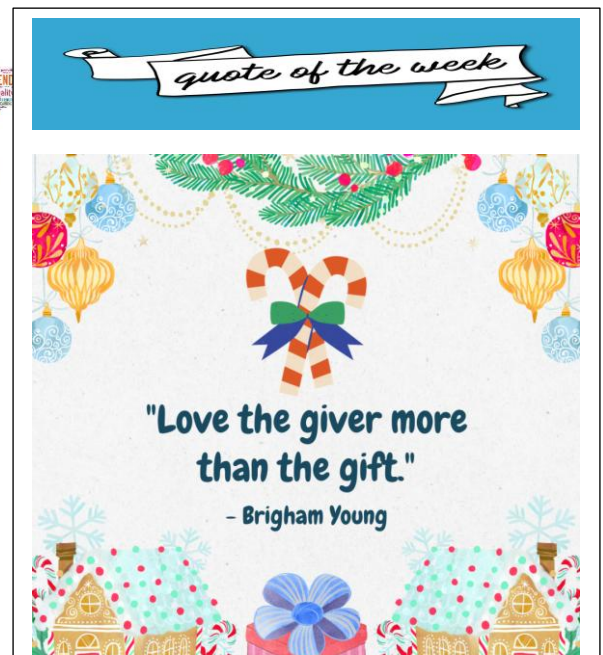
