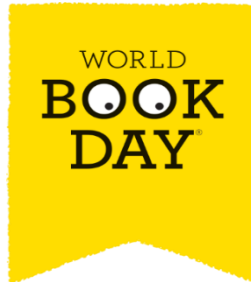

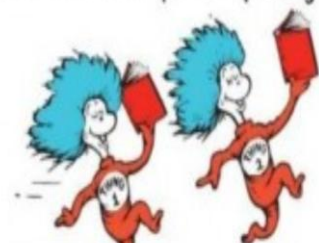
We had a great time celebrating World Book Day on Thursday this week. We came dressed as our favourite book characters or wearing our pyjamas ready for a bedtime story.

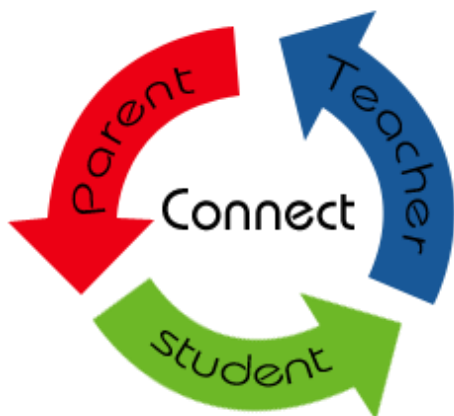


Attendance update - 95.2% Whole school
