Safeguarding / Online Safety Notice: Protecting Your Child This Christmas:

As Christmas approaches and many children receive new technology, we urge parents to remain vigilant about their child's online activity. When you gift a device that can access the internet, you're not just gifting the device itself:

you're giving a portal to the entire online world. And while that includes all the fun bits, like chatting with friends and finding new favourite games, it also comes with a whole host of potential safeguarding risks.

Popular platforms such as WhatsApp, Xbox/PlayStation gaming chats, and social media apps like TikTok and Instagram often expose children to risks such as cyberbullying, inappropriate content, and contact from strangers. Please note that most of these platforms have age restrictions for a reason:

- WhatsApp/Instagram/TikTok: 13+
- Xbox/PlayStation online gaming: 18+ games often have unrestricted chat features.

Research shows a significant rise in online grooming cases, with the NSPCC reporting over 6,000 incidents last year linked to platforms like Instagram. Gaming chat features have also been flagged by the police for enabling harmful interactions.

We strongly advise you to:

- Supervise and monitor technology use and adjust settings to avoid contact from strangers.
- Regularly discuss online safety with your child. Please visit the Safeguarding page on our website for all information regarding online safety as well as all the platform guides.
- Follow recommended age guidelines.

We have attached guides on setting up and monitoring devices that your children may have access to. Your vigilance can make all the difference in keeping your children safe.

NHS Pharmacy First Service:

Did you know that the NHS Pharmacy First Service enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate, for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment?

There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local Boots pharmacy with their child and ask for help under the service.

Support for the following conditions can be accessed under the service, free of charge (unless NHS prescription

charges apply):

Common condition	Patient eligibility
Earache	1 to 17 years
Impetigo	1 year and over
Infected insect bites and stings	1 year and over
Sore throats	5 years and over
Sinusitis	12 years and over
Uncomplicated urinary tract	Women 16 to 64 years
Shingles	18 years and over
