Mummification
Step 1 - Clean the body.
Step 2 - Remove the organs and put in canopic jars. Pull the brain out using a hook.
Step 3 - Dry the body out using natron salt.
Step 4 - Stuff and wrap the body in linen bandages.
Step 5 - Add amulets to accompany to the afterlife.
Step 6 - Make a death mask and put the body into a coffin or sarcophagus.

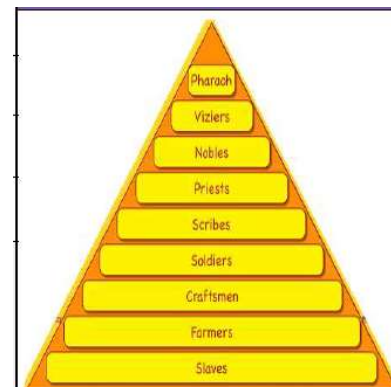
