Mummification

- Step 1 Clean the body.
- Step 2 Remove the organs and put in canopic jars. Pull the brain out using a hook.
- Step 3 Dry the body out using natron salt.
- Step 4 Stuff and wrap the body in linen bandages.
- Step 5 Add amulets to accompany to the afterlife.
- Step 6 Make a death mask and put the body into a coffin or sarcophagus.


