The successful candidate will work closely with the class teacher, SENDCo and wider staff team to support pupils with a range of needs including autism, ADHD, speech and language needs, sensory differences and social communication difficulties.

Experience supporting pupils with complex needs and **training in Positive Handling (or willingness to undertake training)** is highly desirable.

This is a temporary position offered on a fixed-term basis. There may be an opportunity for the post to become permanent, subject to staffing needs and funding.

- Provide 1:1 and small-group support for neurodiverse pupils
- Support communication, emotional regulation and learning development

- Implement behaviour support strategies and individual plans
 - Promote independence, wellbeing and inclusion
 - Use de-escalation strategies and safe positive handling techniques where appropriate
 - Support pupils during transitions, playtimes and structured learning
 - Occasionally support the school's Breakfast Club from **7:30am**
