This term, we will learn about Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole, and Edith Cavell, three nurses who helped people during illness and war. Their courage and care improved hospitals, saved lives, and changed nursing. By comparing their achievements, we will see how individuals can make a difference nationally and internationally, linking to the Year 2 National Curriculum focus on **significant individuals in the past**.
