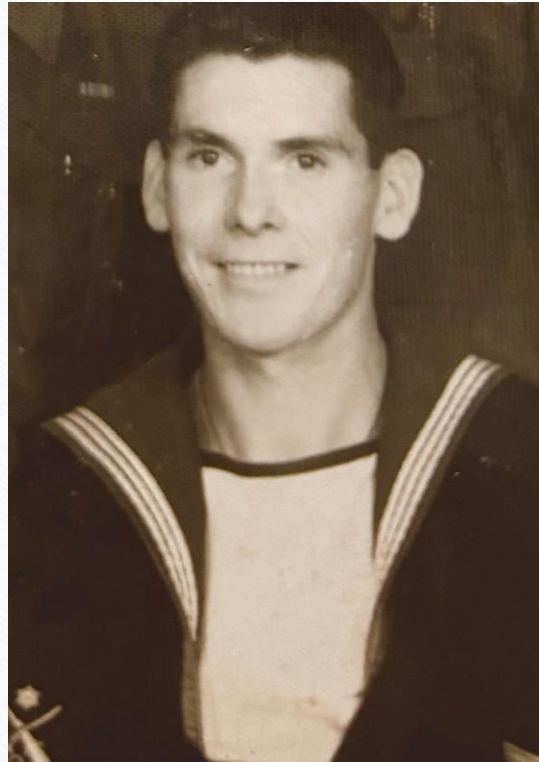

WILLIAM SERVED THROUGH THE 2ND WORLD WAR. HE FOUGHT IN NORTH AFRICA, ITALY AND GREECE IN THE ROYAL TANK REGIMENT. HE WAS A TANK COMMANDER IN CHARGE OF A SQUADRON OF TANKS. WILLIAM WAS AWARDED THE MILITARY MEDAL FOR GALLANTRY IN GREECE. THIS WAS AN AWARD GIVEN FOR EXEMPLARY BRAVERY IN THE FACE OF THE ENEMY. WILLIAM SURVIVED THE WAR AND RETURNED TO HIS JOB AS A COAL MINER.



Lance Corporal Eric Sharples Harriet C's Great, Great Grandad (Year 4)



ERIC WAS CALLED UP ON THE FIRST DAY OF WW2 INTO THE ROYAL ENGINEERS. HE WENT TO FRANCE WITH THE BRITISH EXPEDITIONARY FORCE IN SEPTEMBER 1939 TO DEFEND AGAINST GERMAN INVASION.

ERIC'S UNIT WAS THE NUMBER 2 DOCKS GROUP RESPONSIBLE FOR OPERATING THE FRENCH CHANNEL PORTS. AS THE GERMAN FORCES WERE CAPTURING THE PORTS, HE WAS EVACUATED ON 25TH MAY 1940 JUST BEFORE THE DUNKIRK EVACUATION.

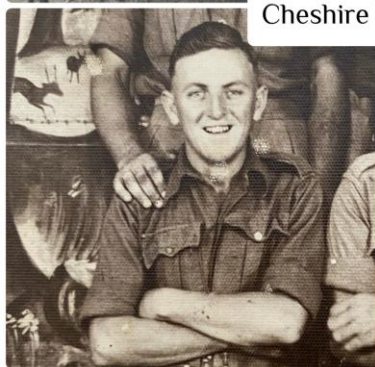

“WHILE BEING OUT ON PATROL IN HELMOND, AFGHANISTAN. WE ENTERED A TOWN WHERE WE CAME UNDER GUNFIRE FOR A GOOD HOUR. AFTER THE SHOOTING STOPPED, THE VILLAGE CHILDREN CAME TO SEE US WHICH TOLD US IT WAS NOW SAFE. I REMEMBER HOW THE SHOOTING DIDN'T BOTHER THEM, BUT SPEAKING THROUGH OUR TRANSLATOR, ALL THEY CARED ABOUT WAS IF THEY COULD HAVE THE PEN I WAS USING AS THEIR SCHOOL DIDN'T HAVE ANY. I GAVE THEM THE PEN AND A FEW OTHER THINGS.”

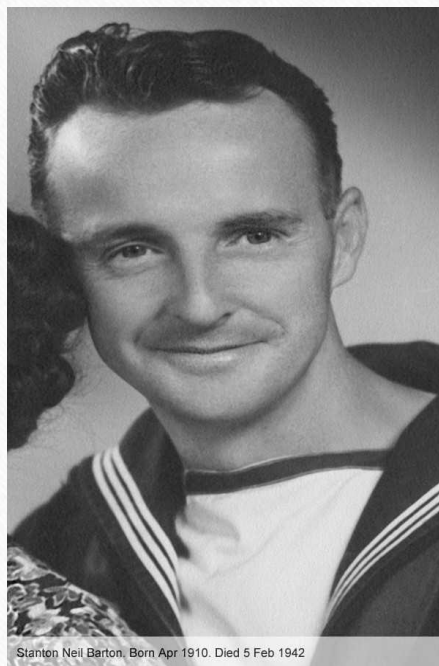

"I DEPLOYED TO AFGHANISTAN IN 2012 AS AN INFANTRY SOLDIER WITH THE 1ST BATTALION, THE DUKE OF LANCASTER'S REGIMENT, TO SUPPORT THE AFGHAN POLICE/ARMY FIGHTING AGAINST THE TALIBAN IN AN AREA CALLED NAD E ALI IN THE HELMAND PROVINCE. I WAS THERE FOR 4 MONTHS AWAY FROM FRIENDS AND FAMILY. EACH DAY WE WOULD HAVE DIFFERENT TASKS, THE FIRST PICTURE WAS WHEN I FIRST ARRIVED, THE NEXT ONE WAS TAKEN IN THE GUARD TOWER WHERE I PROVIDED SAFETY AND SECURITY. WE TOOK TURNS TO KEEP WATCH WHILST THE OTHER MEMBERS OF MY UNIT SLEPT AND RECOVERED. THE OTHER PICTURE WAS ON PATROLS IN THE LOCAL AREA, AS YOU CAN SEE THE WEATHER WAS VERY HOT UP TO AROUND 30-40 DEGREES IN THE DAY AND DROPPING TO -10 AT NIGHT. MY KIT AND EQUIPMENT AT THE HEAVIEST WEIGHED ABOUT 50KG AND ON PATROLS WE COVERED ABOUT 20KM PER DAY, OCCASIONALLY COMING UP AGAINST OUR ADVERSARIES WHICH WAS WHEN THE HARD WORK WOULD START."
