





Our topic is... Into the Woods!




Reading



English



This term, in our writing lessons we will be learning about different sentence types including statement, command, question and exclamation sentences. We will write instructions and a narrative. You can help by helping your child to practice can spelling all the Year 2 Common Exception Words.



Maths

In Maths this term, we will be learning about multiplication and division. We will learn to be fluent with our 2x, 5x and 10x tables. We will also learn about fractions of number and shape and be able to identify 1/4, 1/2 and 1/3 of a number and shape. We will learn to tell the time to half past, quarter past,



Maths Meetings

In Maths Meetings, we will practise counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s. We will consolidate the value of each digit in a 2-digit number. We will practise number bonds and addition and subtraction up to 20, and use this to consolidate facts up to 100. We'll revisit our learning of shape and accurately describe 2D and 3D shapes. We will practise telling the time to O'Clock and half past. We will use a calendar and be able to talk about yesterday, tomorrow and next month.





Science

In Science this term, we are learning about plants. We will learn about what plants need to survive and their life cycles. We will continue to develop our working scientifically skills through experimenting in the Forest School.



History

In History this term, we will learn about castles. We will find out why castles were built, what medieval society was like and who The Normans were. We will learn about the Battle of Hastings and how we find out about the past when it's so long ago!



Geography

In Geography this term, we will learn about the human and physical features of land and why people chose to build castles in certain places, e.g. on a hill, near a source of water. We will also develop our fieldwork skills using the forest school.



Art

This term, we will be learning about how artists take inspiration from nature. We will look at the sculptor Andy Goldsworthy and how he uses natural patterns. We will also look at the work of Georgia O'Keeffe.



DT

We will learn to join materials together and make strong and stable structures by making cardboard castles.



Computing

We will continue to develop our coding skills. We will also work on creating documents, saving them and retrieving them.



Music

We will continue with our weekly ukulele lessons. We will also be listening to Peter and The Wolf and appraising it, thinking about which instruments can be heard.



PSHE

In PSHE, we'll be learning about living in the wider world. We will be thinking about belonging to a group and how we fit into our community.
