Classroom Routines

Our PE days are Mondays and Wednesdays.

All children will need black shorts/joggers, white t-shirts and black pumps/trainers. The children can come to school in their kit and stay in it all day.

Bagels

Children are able to have a toasted bagel in the morning as part of our 'magic breakfast' scheme. There is no charge for this.

Snacks & Water

In Year 1 and 2 we provide fruit each day. If your child brings their own snack, please provide something healthy. Crisps and chocolate are not allowed. Please provide a *water* bottle for your child every day, and then they can fill it up as they wish throughout the day.

Reading

Your child will bring home a reading book each day, closely matched to their own level of reading.

Please can you read with your child **every day** for a few minutes and sign their reading diary. Little and often is much better than a long session once a week.

Please can you send the reading book into school EVERY DAY, as we try to read with all the children as often as possible in school too.

We will aim to change your child's book twice per week as long as they have been reading it regularly at school and at home. This will help them to make rapid progress.

If you have any questions about reading or phonics, please don't hesitate to ask me and I will do my best to answer your query.





How can I use this?

The curriculum expects a lot from the children in Year 2 and it is vital that they do work at home with you.

This overview of the curriculum for the <u>Autumn</u> term is to give you some information that will help you to support your child.

Mathematics



This term we will be covering:

- Place Value within 100
- Addition and Subtraction of 2-digit numbers
- Shape

We follow the White Rose Hub for Maths and each term we complete assessments based on what the children have learned.

English


This term we will be using Read, Write Inc and books linked to our topic **The Great Fire of London** to stimulate the children's writing.

Children will complete Phonics, writing and handwriting daily. In Phonics, children will be grouped with other children across Year 1, 2 and 3 who are working at the same level.

We will then be able to address any gaps in children's learning and tailor their needs more specifically. Children will still cover the normal literacy objectives through this scheme.

This term we will be mainly be learning how to write effective sentences for a narrative. We will also be entering writing into the BBC 500 words competition.

Below is the **Read-Write-Inc. colouring and grouping system**. Ask your child which group they are in and look to see where that fits in here. Also their reading books will be linked to their RWI colour band.



The main homework is for the children to read every day at home.

We will also provide TT Rockstars/Numbots and Spelling Shed passwords for them to use at home.

Creative Curriculum

Our topic for the creative curriculum this term is 'The Great Fire of London Through this topic, children will cover Geography, History, Art and DT objectives.

We will be doing lots of exciting activities, such as:

- Building a free-standing structure.
- Identifying famous landmarks in London.
- Learning about the Great Fire of London.
- A trip to Staircase House in Stockport.

In **Science** we will be studying Seasonal Change (across the whole year), Plants and Animals including humans. We will be growing some of our own plants and learning to recognise common leaves and flowers from the UK.

In **RE** our big questions are: Who is Jewish and what do they believe? What can we learn from sacred books?

In PSHE we will be learning all about 'me and my world' and 'celebrating differences'.

In Computing we will be learning about online safety, effective searching and Lego Builders.

In **Music** we will be following the Stockport Music Scheme looking at Rhythm and Composition and Music Ensemble and Performance.

In PE this term we will be following the Get Set for PE scheme and covering Dance, Invasion Games, Gymnatics and Ball Skills.
