Happy Friday Everyone!


Well here we are at the end of our first half-term, and what an amazing half-term it has been! There has been lots of amazing learning going on across the classes, supported by visits and visitors!


<u>Forest Schools-</u> The first session of Forest Schools after the break will be on <u>Thursday 6th November and is for Reception Badgers.</u>




School Lottery:
