We expect that parents will support the principle of homework and it is expected that all children will complete homework set. We recognise that some homework is via devices, but the apps can be used easily on a phone. We ask parents to let us know if it is not possible to access them. Parents should liaise with the class teacher regarding any homework issues.

The children have logins to support their work at home on the following programmes:

These logins are stuck in the children's reading records

Holidays

There will be occasions when homework will be set during the school holidays, including reading/timestables. However, if families are away it is understood that children may not have the time to complete set work. Children taking holidays in school term time will not be given extra work by the class teacher as it is an unauthorised absence from school.

The homework set at Abingdon is a manageable daily amount and it focuses on the key skills children need. Children need to do things little and often to help retain the information.
