

Year 1 Enjoy Hands-On STEM Workshop




A big thank you to Junior STEM for delivering such an engaging and inspiring workshop and well done to Year 1 for their brilliant effort and learning!



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

It was wonderful to see everybody so enthusiastically rising to the challenge of learning something new, getting active and connecting with others to promote positive well-being.










(Please note this is an invite for parents to experience the new school meal provision; there is no charge).




Sewing Club
