We discussed budgeting, and the importance of maintaining a surplus budget in case of any unexpected outgoings, such as vet bills or cars breaking down!



<p><b>In the classroom...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Tuck in your chair</li><li>Sit still- do not rock or swing on the chairs</li><li>Keep your classroom tidy and clutter free</li></ul> 	<p><b>In the lunch hall...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Stay sitting while eating</li><li>Put your hand up if you need help</li><li>Keep noise levels low</li></ul>

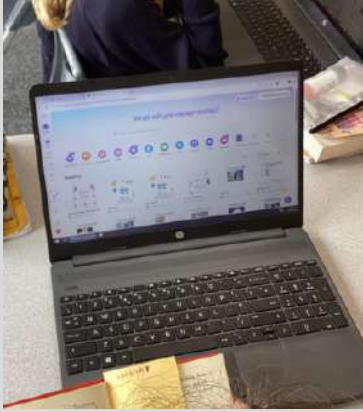
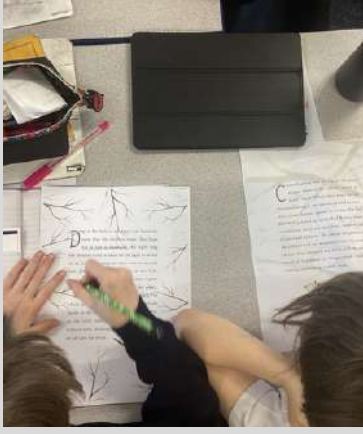
