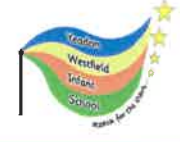




Yeadon Westfield Infant School Parent Information Sheet

In English we will:

Speaking and Listening- We will be encouraging children to speak in full sentences, explaining their thinking. Please encourage this at home too!

We will be learning- Phonics: Phase 3 sounds: sh, th, ng, ai, ee, and consolidating all previous taught sounds.

*Blending and segmenting words with the above sounds.

*To recognise and spell basic sight vocabulary, including the 'red' words: his, be, me, has, no, so, her, do, my, by, ask, says, they, said, was, put, all, were.

Continue to form letters in print. Writing words and simple sentences.

ENJOY sharing stories and writing with your child.

Topic work:

UTW- comparing old and new toys.

*Counting 10 objects accurately

* Recognising and understanding numbers to 10 and beyond

* Learning 3+3, 4+4, 5+5

*Adding 1 digit numbers

* Subtracting 1 digit numbers

* Division- sharing objects fairly

* Recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes

* Doubling numbers 1-5
