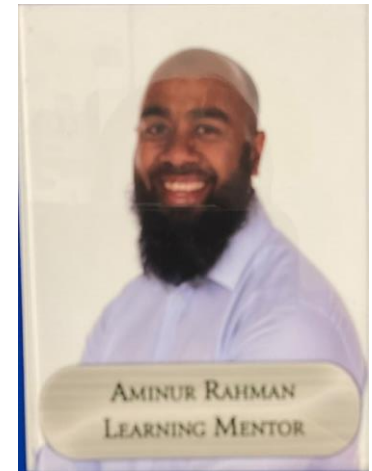
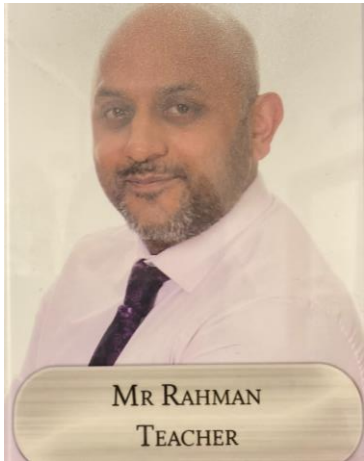

Writing

- All times tables (12 x 12) – quick recall
- Place value with 4 digit numbers

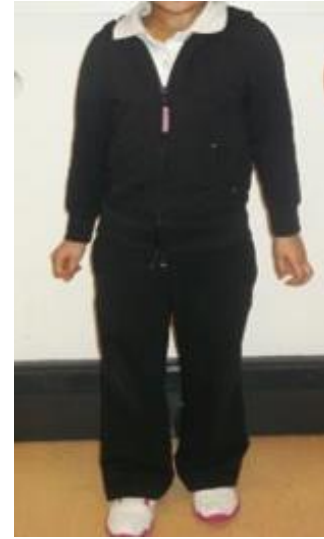

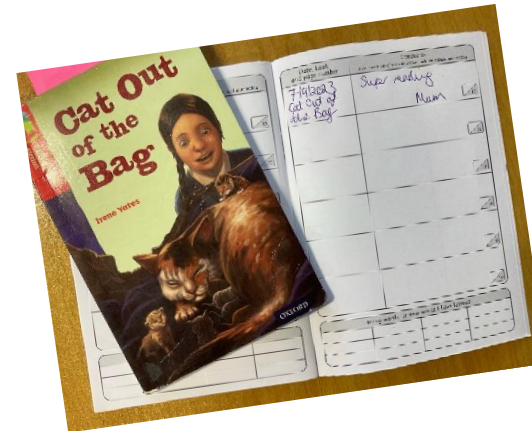
Spellings
