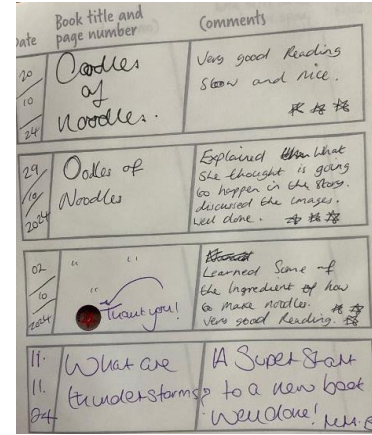
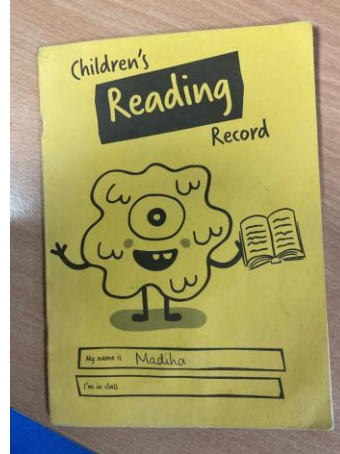
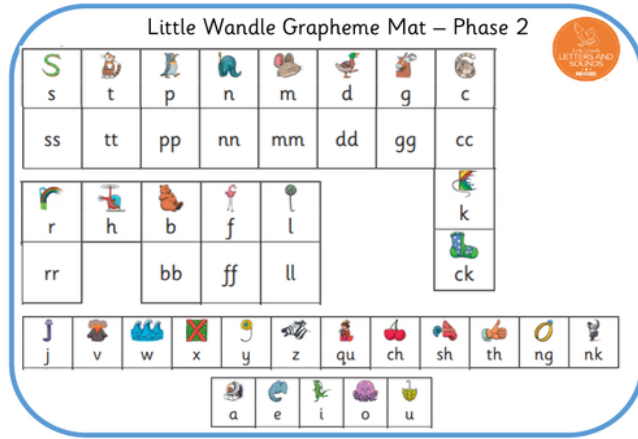
SCHOOL ATTENDANCE EVERY DAY COUNTS
