


### SATs


 During the Summer Term Year 2 children will take part in the national SAT tests. These will consist of 2 Reading Papers, 2 Maths papers where one tests arithmetic ability nad the other reasoning ability, a Spelling paper and a Grammar paper.

### Phonic Screening

- During the month of June 2023 children in Year 1 and children who were not successful previously will participate in the Phonics Screening check. Children will be tested on their phonic ability with 20 real words and 20 pseudo words.
- You can support your children by ensuring weekly home learning is complete, daily reading occurs and practising spellings for weekly quizzes.








