This week we have continued to focus on helping children understand their emotions through the Zones of Regulation.

The Blue Zone is when we might feel sad, tired, sick, or low in energy. It's important for children to recognise when they are in the Blue Zone so they can use helpful strategies—like talking to a trusted adult, taking a short break, or engaging in a calming activity—to feel more alert and ready for learning.

By learning about the Blue Zone, children gain the tools to manage their feelings in healthy ways, both at school and at home.
