



# Your Local Inclusion Support Offer (LISO)

The Local Inclusion Support Offer (LISO) is a structured framework of support services, interventions, and guidance provided by a local partners to help schools and early years settings meet the needs of children and young people with SEND at the earliest possible stage.

<p><b>What is it?</b></p> <p>It is a navigation tool or ‘map’ which shows you the services/resources/projects available to support schools and settings. As this is an evolving document some services may not yet be represented (but are still available). These are not new services and they will all currently be accessed in the same way they always have, with the same criteria. This is a way of showing in one place who those services are and when you could be utilising their support</p>	<p><b>How do I use it?</b></p> <p>You can use this as an aide memoir as to what is available to your setting You can use it to reflect on what you have already accessed and/or the level of support you are at You can use it to give you a starting point as to who to speak to get more help &amp; guidance.</p> <p><i>We would recommend sharing this in your setting to whole staff</i></p>
<p><b>Why is it organised like it is?</b></p> <p>Following work with leaders and SENCOs last academic year we have organised this by area of SEND need on their request and also tried to keep the information brief so that this is useful to everyone in settings.</p> <p>More detailed information, e.g. for SENCOs is available directly from services.</p> <p>It is intended to support whole school development and a graduated response to individual needs and uses the new DfE terminology of training, advice &amp; direct delivery to support this understanding.</p>	<p><b>How can I get help with it?</b></p> <p>As this is a summative document we understand that you may need further help in accessing the right offer from the most appropriate service.</p> <p>Our ‘LISO Navigators’ are available to help you in their designated area and you can contact them if you are unsure about how to use this or where to go for support.</p>





# Early Intervention and a Graduated Response

The Department for Education have introduced some new terminology – **training, advice & direct delivery** – which we have to use as part of the LISO.

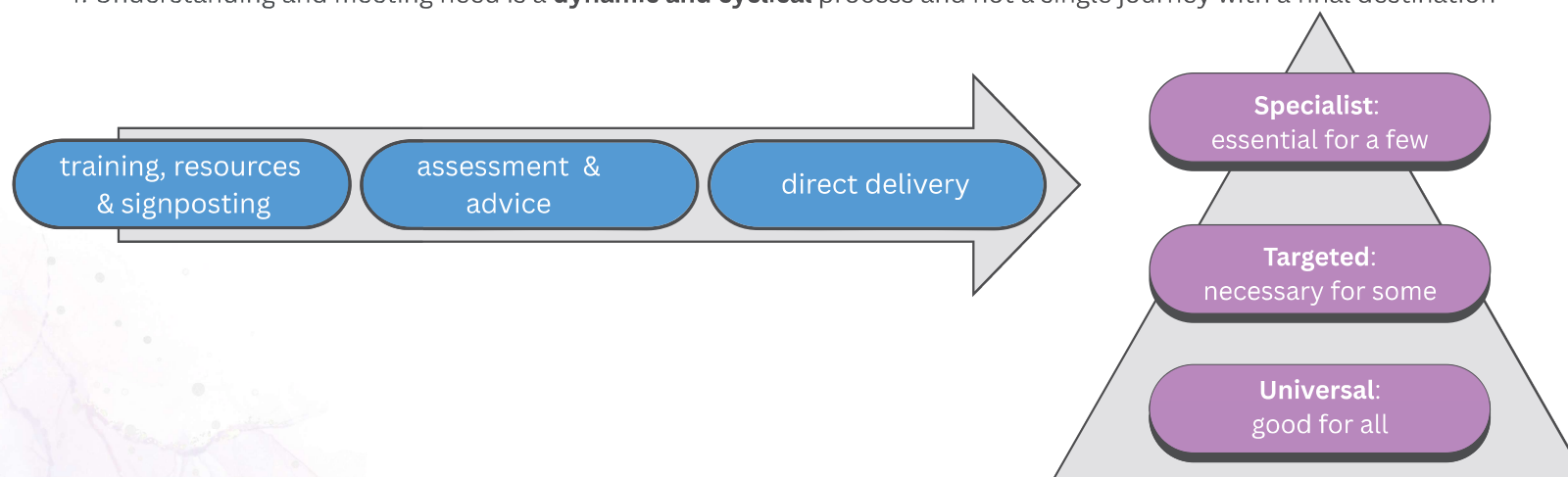
We understand that there are already different models and associated terminology out there, e.g.

- Graduated Response – Assess, Plan, Do, Review
- iThrive – Getting advice, Getting help, Getting more help, Getting risk support
  - Universal, Targeted & Specialist
- Alternative Provision 3-Tiered Model

Our understanding is that the preferred language of schools and setting is **universal, targeted and specialist** and so we have shown where this sits alongside the new DfE terminology for this LISO.

We have also taken the view that any model is predicated on the same basic principles:

1. **Whole school practice** underpins any individual or group intervention, reflects systemic inclusion and reduces the need for lots of individual interventions
2. The **earlier** we intervene the better
3. **Understanding need** is crucial to meeting need (which is why we have added ‘assessment’ in alongside ‘advice’)
4. Understanding and meeting need is a **dynamic and cyclical** process and not a single journey with a final destination
