Summer Term Topic

The Ancient Egyptians and the Noble Nile!

We are learning about...

The history of the Ancient Egyptians, including when and where they lived, what life was like, and all their incredible achievements including the amazing ancient pyramids. Why not research King Tutankhamun? We will then study the River Nile as part of our Geography topic.



In Science, we will be learning about skeletons, muscles and movement before studying nutrition. In art, we will create Ancient Egyptian clay cartouches and our own pharaoh self-portraits.

English

In our English, we will write incredible instructions on how to mummify a body, just like an Ancient Egyptian embalmer! We will then look at the story 'Egyptian Cinderella' and write our own versions, before moving to write a non-chronological report all about the Ancient Egyptians.

Maths

This term, we will learn to multiply using the grid method. It really



helps to know our times tables, so keep practising the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. We ask that children practice on TT Rockstars for at least 20 minutes a week to help them learn.

Reading

It is extremely important for children to read at least <u>3 times</u> <u>a week</u> at home. Write in your child's reading record so that they can become a Reading Champion at the end of the half term.

Remember to encourage your child to login to myON weekly to read some books and complete the quizzes.
