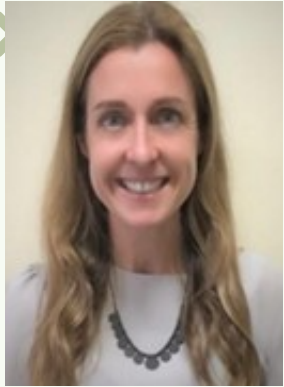


Westwood Academy Newsletter

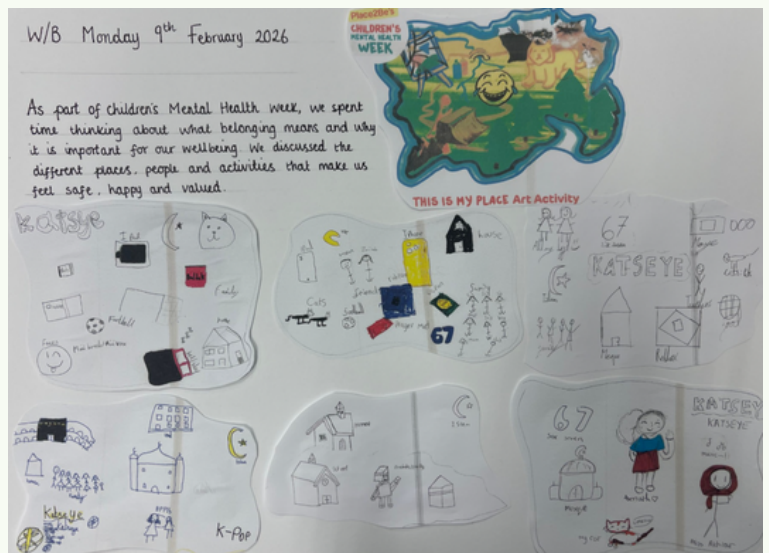
