Autumn and Celebrations

We will be learning about the season of Autumn and looking at how the weather has changed and the nights are darker. We are going to read a book called **Owl Babies** to help us learn about animals that are awake at night. We will be finding out what baby owls are called? What do they eat? We will go on autumn walks in the schools grounds to look at changes to the trees. We will continue to read lots of stories to help support our re telling skills.

We will be introducing the children to Tales Toolkit. This is our story telling tool. We have a character bag, a setting, a problem (because most stories have a problem) and a solution bag to solve the problem. It helps develop childrens vocabulary and sentence structures. It is very imaginative and creative.

How can you help?

Please continue to encourage your child to become more independent with dressing skills. Finding & putting on their own coats then hanging it up. Extending this to getting dressed will be a super life-long skill too.

Please label all your child's clothing and belongings, this will allow us to return clothes more easily if they get mislaid.

What is WellComm?

We are using a language intervention programme to support and develop your children's language

WellComm is a Speech and Language Toolkit for Screening and Intervention in the Early Years that plays a crucial role in identifying children with potential language difficulties and offers a range of customised intervention activities to help support their language development.
