## Animal Kingdom

We will be learning about the season of Winter and looking at how the weather is colder and wearing warmer clothes. We are going to read a book called **Dear Zoo** to help us learn about animals that live in the jungle. We will be finding out about different wild animals? What do they eat? We will look at how they move and the colours of their skin. We will continue to read lots of stories to help support our re telling skills. We will use mathematical vocabulary to describe the size of animals and continue to subitise to 3 and identify representations of 1, 2, 3.

Others texts we are using **Monkey and me** and **Which bum's mums**.

We are continuing to use tales toolkit and drawing club as it helps develop childrens vocabulary and sentence structures. It is very imaginative and creative.

Last half term we enjoyed lots of new experiences. We performed in our EYFS Nativity. We met some owls and other nocturnal animals. We can't wait to continue the children's learning and development at Holden Clough Nursery.
