In this gymnastics unit, 5DLhave learnt how to control their bodies through a variety of balances and jumps. They practise holding still shapes—such as one-point, two-point, and partner balances—while focusing on body tension, core strength, and good posture. Students also explore different types of jumps, including straight, tuck, star, and half-turn jumps, working on taking off and landing safely with bent knees and controlled movement. Throughout the unit, pupils created short sequences that link balances and jumps smoothly, showing creativity, coordination, and confidence!
