
Book change day: Please ensure your child's book is in school on either a Wednesday or Friday. See the front of their reading diary for your book change day.

Science

This half term we will learn about 'Animals including humans'. We will:

- Draw and label human body parts.
- Identify the body parts associated with each sense.
- Compare and group body parts.
- Begin to recognise patterns in data and use these to answer questions.
- Record data in a table.




English

This half term we will be writing our own narrative based on the story "Dadaji's paintbrush" by Rashmi Sirdeshpande and our own fact files based on the text 'Iggy Peck Architect' by Andrea Beaty and David Roberts.

We will also be developing our writing skills by producing, posters, captions, letters, speech bubbles and a report.

We will focus on:

- Application of taught phonics when writing.
- Forming letters correctly.
- Leaving spaces between words.
- Using capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Orally rehearsing sentences and reading sentences out loud.
- Using adjectives to add detail.
- Using and, but, so to join clauses.
- Using adverbials of time.



What can you do at home?

Read lots of stories with your child.

Listen to your child read as much as possible. Remember to sign the reading diaries to earn a raffle ticket!

RE

In RE we will be explore the question: Who is Jewish and what do they believe?

We will:

- Describe what precious items they have and explain why they are important.
- Reflect on their own experiences of celebration and remembrance in their families.
- Explain the significance of the Shema and how it is represented in the Mezuzah.
- Identify and describe at least three practices associated with Shabbat.
- Share a story related to Chanukah and express what it teaches about faith and God.

Geography:

Our geography unit is called:

Through this unit we will:

- Name and locate the four countries on a map of the UK.
- Identify the country we live in.
- Identify the four compass directions.
- Use the compass directions to describe the location of features.
- Observe and describe daily weather patterns.
- Begin to locate the four capital cities of the UK.
- Explain what the weather is like during each season in the UK.
- Suggest appropriate clothing and activities for each season.

- how to stay healthy.
- about things that help us feel good.

We will also continue to focus on Character Strengths. We will think about what we appreciate about ourselves and our top strengths.

Maths:


Choose a teen number (13-19). Create a poster to show all of the number bonds to create that number.

Geography


- Keep a weather diary for the week and watch a weather forecast on TV.
