We are looking forward to the next half term

Last half term we enjoyed lots of new experiences. We had sessions from story makers. We learnt how to subitise to 3 and we learnt new preposition language using a book called Up and Down.



In Nursery our next topic will be,

Out and about

We will be learning about different types of transport and how things move? We are going to read a book called **Naughty bus and Emma Janes aeroplane**. We will be looking at a world map to see where Emma travels in her aeroplane. We are going to look at a book called **Whatever next**. This is to develop our imaginative skills and retelling skills. We will continue to read lots of stories to help support new vocabulary. We will use mathematical vocabulary such as more and fewer, continue to subitise to 3 and children develop one to one correspondence. Others texts we are using **Astro Girl** and **You can't take an elephant on the bus**.

We are continuing to use tales toolkit as it helps develop childrens vocabulary and sentence structures. It is very imaginative and creative.


How can you help?

Before your child can learn to write, he or she needs to be able to draw these shapes



Children who can draw an oblique cross are able to copy more letters and numbers than children who cannot
