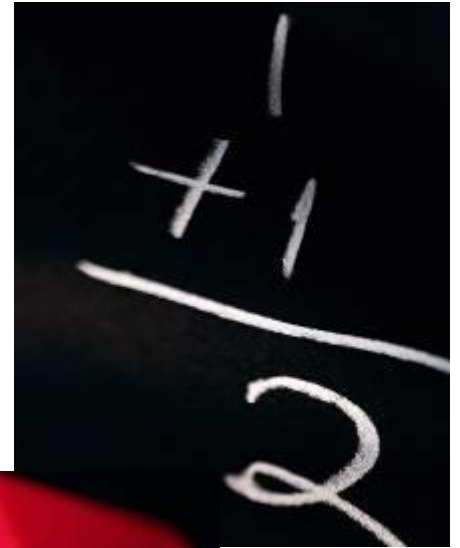
# Why are we all together?

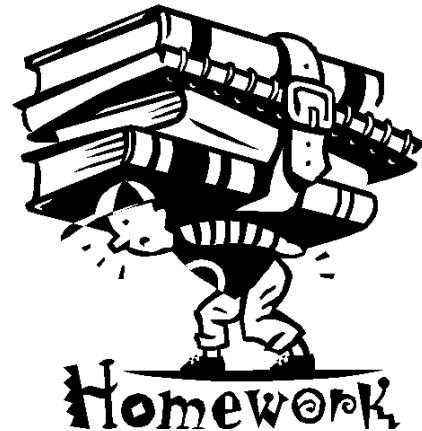

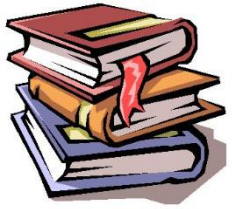


# Swimming


