1	There are 5 senses—sight, hearing, touch, smell and taste.	
2	The human body is made up of different parts e.g. head, arms, legs, ears, elbow, knee, hands etc.	
3	Humans are mammals, which means they have fur/hair and feed milk to their young.	
4	There are different types of animals - mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds and fish.	
5	Some animals are carnivores and eat meat. Some animals are herbivores and eat plants. Omnivores are animals that eat both.

1	Mammals	Mammals are animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.	
2	Reptiles	All reptiles breathe air. They have scales on their skin. They lay their eggs on land.	
3	Amphibians	Amphibians live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older. They have smooth, slimy skin.	
4	Birds	All birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.	
5	Fish	Fish live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and they breathe through gills.
