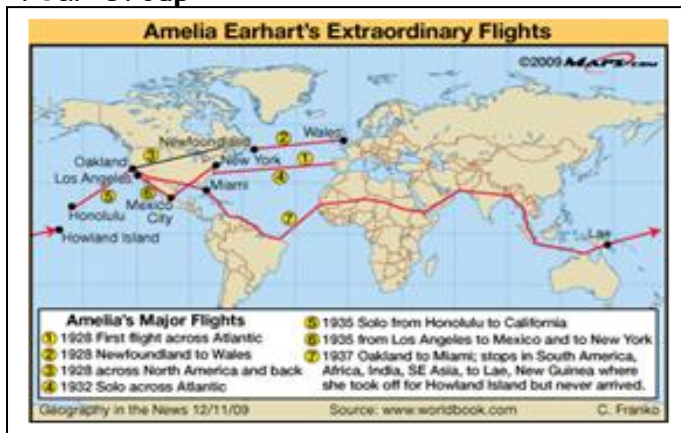


# Transport from the 1920s to the present day

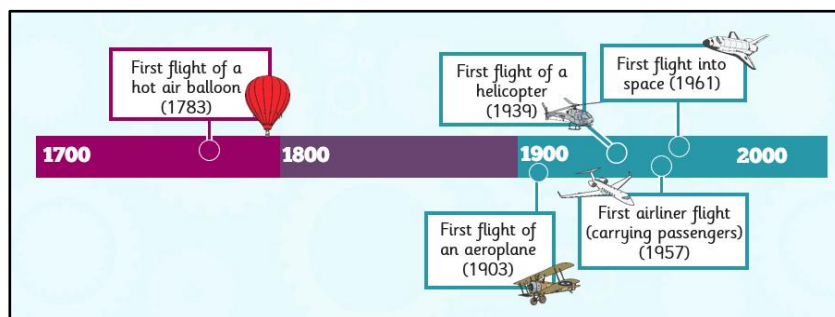
## What I should already know about:

<b>Travel</b>	To move from one place to another.
<b>Transport</b>	Carrying people or goods from one place to another.
<b>Explorer</b>	A person who travels to places that we know little about to find out about them.
<b>Navigate</b>	To plan or direct the route of a ship, plane or car using maps.
<b>Pilot</b>	A person who drives a vehicle such as an aeroplane, boat or spacecraft.
<b>Aviation</b>	Flying or operating an aircraft.
<b>Timeline</b>	a line of events to show the order in which they happened
<b>Chronological</b>	A list of events in time order.
