Key vocabulary

Sculpture	A piece of art that is made 3D.
Elements of art	Important parts of a piece of art, they are tools which artists use to communicate a message.
Shape	An element of art which is a 2D design created by a closed line. They are simple outlines which artists can fill with different colours, shades or patters. It could be a square or a more natural shape, such as a leaf.
Form	Form is a 3D shape like a cube, a cone or a pyramid. Form is very important in sculpture.
