



Vehicles

Key Vocabulary

Vehicle	A vehicle is something with wheels that transports people or objects, such as a car, truck or cart.
Wheel	A circular object that is fixed below a vehicle or object to allow it to move easily on the ground.
Axle	An axle is a rod or spindle (either fixed or rotating) that passes through the centre of a wheel so that it can be attached to a vehicle.
Chassis	The chassis is the framework for the vehicle and attaches the axles and the wheels to the body of the vehicle.
Washer	A metal, rubber or plastic ring that prevents the wheel from coming off the axle as they are turning.
Rotate	To turn an object around a centre point.
Vehicle body	The outer covering of a motor vehicle, normally made of metal, fibreglass or plastic.
