Key Vocabulary

The Ten Commandments	These were rules that God had made to tell people how they should live.
Sabbath	A day of holiness from sunset on Friday to nightfall of the following day.
Passover	Passover is a Jewish holiday that honours the freedom of the Israelites, or Jewish slaves.
Hanukkah	Hanukkah is one of the many holidays in the Jewish calendar, also known as the festival of lights, Hanukkah takes place over eight days. Each night, a candle is lit on the Menorah (or Hanukkah).
The Torah	Jewish holy book.
The Kippah.	A small cap worn by Jewish males as a sign of Jewish identity.
Mezuzah	A small box placed on the right doorpost of Jewish homes.
Shema prayer	A Jewish prayer that serves as a centrepiece of the morning and evening Jewish prayer services.
