WALT 6: To explore food chains in a habitat.



Key Vocabulary

Habitat	A natural environment or home of a variety of plants or animals.
Living	An organism that moves, grows, responds, respires, reproduces, get rid of waste.
Never alive	These objects cannot move, grow, respire, reproduce, eat or do any other things that plants and animals can do.
Micro-habitat	A very small habitat, for example woodlice under stones, logs or leaf litter.
Food chain	A food chain shows how each living thing gets its food. Some animals eat plants and some animals eat other animals.
