Decade	a period of ten years.
Century	A period of 100 years
Timeline	A line of events to show the order in which they happened.
Chronological	A list of events in time order
Fashion	A style of clothing, hair or decoration.
Rock and Roll	A type of popular dance music that started in the 1950s.
Coronation	The ceremony of crowning a king or queen.
Invention	A new thing that someone has made.
