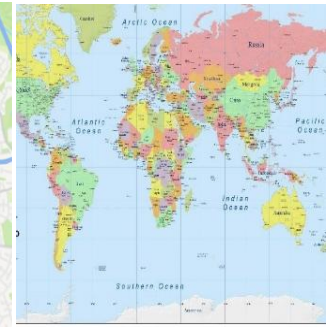
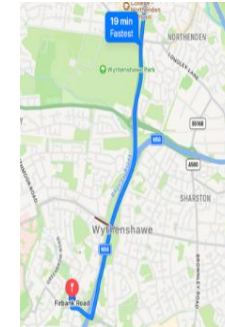

Atlas

An atlas is a collection of maps of the Earth. An atlas shows maps of continents, countries and features such as oceans, rivers, mountains and lakes.

Map

Maps are images of a place, usually drawn from above, that can help you find where you are and where you are going.

Compass

A tool which points out directions, such as North, South, East and West.

Satnav

A system that uses information from satellites to find the best way of getting to a place.

Destination

The place where someone is going or where something is being sent to.

Continent

A continent is a very large landmass e.g. Europe.

Ocean

An ocean is a very large area of salt water. Most of the Earth is covered in ocean.
