

Travel	To move from one place to another.
Transport	Carrying people or goods from one place to another.
Explorer	A person who travels to places that we know little about to find out about them.
Navigate	To plan or direct the route of a ship, plane or car using maps.
Pilot	A person who drives a vehicle such as an aeroplane, boat or spacecraft.
Aviation	Flying or operating an aircraft.
Timeline	a line of events to show the order in which they happened
Chronological	A list of events in time order.
