<b>Bridget Riley</b>	Famous English artist
<b>Optical illusion</b>	Something that tricks the eye by appearing different than what it is
<b>Abstract art</b>	Modern art that uses colour, texture and pattern
<b>Pattern</b>	A design in which light, shapes and colours are repeated
<b>Pointillism</b>	Using dots, lines and small strokes so they blend together from a distance
<b>Exhibitions</b>	A place where art is displayed for an audience
<b>Design</b>	Making a sketch or a plan of your ideas
<b>Evaluate</b>	To reflect on and discuss how well a project has gone

Bridget Riley is an English artist and she enjoyed art from an early age. She spent many hours watching changing light, colour and clouds.

She went on to achieve a degree in art. She is still alive today, can you work out how old she is from her birthday, 24<sup>th</sup> April 1931?
